

THE BUSINESS BUILDER PROGRAMME

In collaboration with Enterprise4Good, UCL School of Management and Fashion Business School, London College of Fashion, UAL have developed a 6-week programme designed to support entrepreneurs or small businesses based in east London.

The Business Builder Programme will be taught in-person with sessions commencing on 30 April 2025 and involving visits to London College of Fashion's east London campus and UCL East in Stratford.

Participants will gain a sound understanding of the entrepreneurial mindset, as well as the tools to develop an effective marketing strategy and interpret financial metrics to make data-informed decisions.

This programme is suitable for local east London small and medium enterprises (SMEs), who are based within east London and have been trading for at least one year and have a minimum of 1-4 employees.

The Business Builder programme is supported by the British Business Bank, the UK's economic development bank breaking down barriers in access to finance for businesses across the UK.
